

## Steps to Implementing Marketing Texts

Marketing text messages are sent within Digital Communication and are typically generalized, serving as awareness messages. To send these messages, financial institutions must obtain a literal opt-in from the customer, in accordance with local texting regulations. Consult your compliance department to confirm requirements. Each message is limited to 140 characters, with 20 characters reserved for the mandatory opt-out option.

## Setup

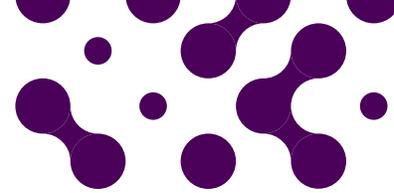
We will create a dedicated toll-free number for your marketing texting. We recommend using a separate number from your operational text messages. Marquis will handle the setup and approval process with mobile carriers. The full setup may take up to four weeks; allow additional time if you choose to SMS-enable an existing toll-free number.

- Assigning a Toll-Free Number
  - If you want to SMS-enable an existing toll-free number, let us know. Otherwise, we'll assign a new one.
- Verifying Your Organization
  - This step is similar to your internal Know Your Customer (KYC) process used when onboarding new customers or businesses.
- Providing Opt-In Disclosure Details
  - Share how recipients will be informed about your opt-in keywords and texting use cases.
  - Include screenshots or disclosure document examples for validation.
- Keyword and Message Setup
  - Our Implementation team will help you create opt-in and opt-out keywords, along with compliant messaging.

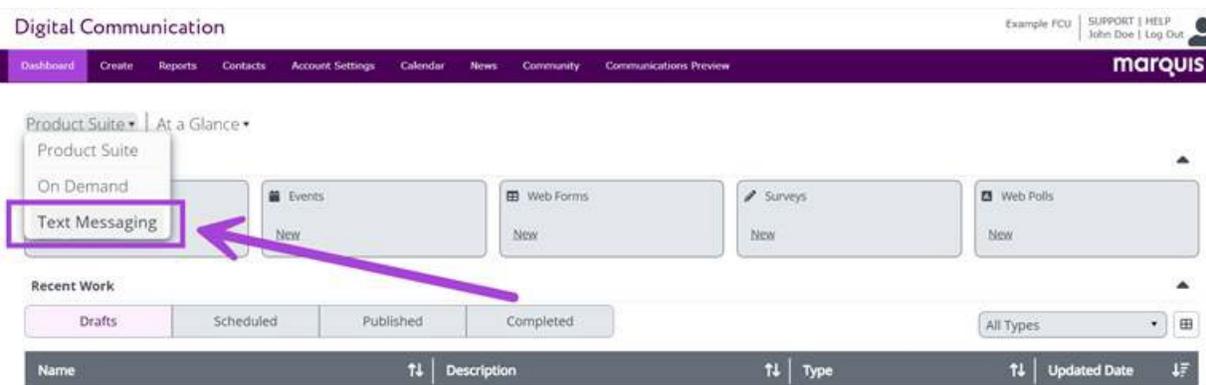

## Getting Started

To create a text message from the Dashboard, click Text Messaging from the drop-down menu. See below.



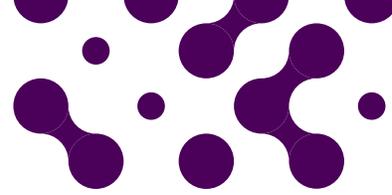
## Creating a Text Message

### Step 1

- Click the **Begin** button to start the message creation process.
- A pop-up titled Add Text Message will appear.

### Step 2

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- (Optional) Choose a **Folder** from the drop-down to organize your message.
  - If no folder is selected, the message will be stored in Unfiled.
- Enter a name for your message in the **SMS Name** field.

## Step 3

- Type your message in the **SMS Text Message** box.
- This is the message your recipients will receive.
- A character counter will appear at the bottom of the box.
  - **Note:** Opt-out language is automatically added—no need to include it manually.

## Step 4

- To preview your message, enter a **Mobile Number** and click **Send Sample**.

## Step 5

- Once your message is ready, click **Submit**.
- Your message will now appear under the appropriate section.

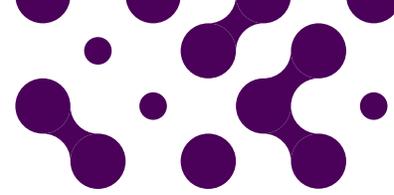

## Publishing a Text Message

### Step 1

- Click on the **Text Message** listed under the **Drafts** section.
- Choose **Publish** from the available options.
  - You may also see options to **Edit** or **Delete** the message.

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## Step 2

- Choose the **Date/Time** when the message should be delivered.
  - This determines when recipients will receive the message.
- (Optional) For new opt-ins, you can schedule an automatic message using **Auto launch to new opt-ins**.

## Step 3

- Select who should receive the message:
  - **All Subscribers**: everyone who has opted in.
  - **Subscribers on Opt-In Date**: users who opted in during a specific timeframe.
    - Example: If you ran a promotion and want to follow up with those who opted in during that period, use this option.

## Step 4

- Enter a **Notification Email** if you'd like to be alerted when delivery is complete.
- Click **Publish** to finalize.
  - The message will now appear under the appropriate status.

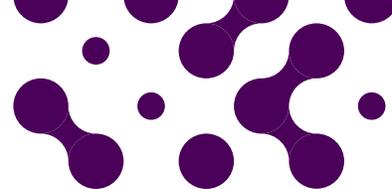
## Text Reports

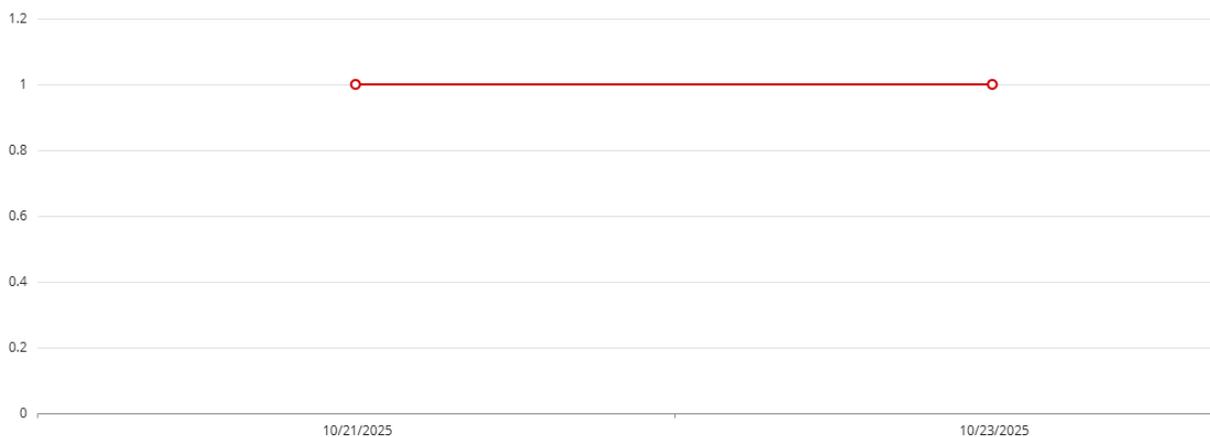
- **Subscriber Summary for Keyword**

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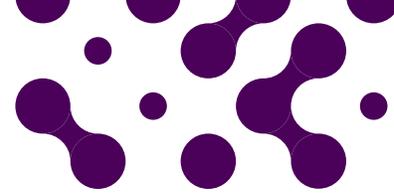
## Manually Opt-Out Mobile Numbers

### Step 1

- While viewing the Text Messaging Dashboard, select the **Gear** Icon within the Recent Work section.

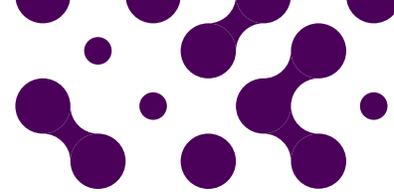
## Guide for Collecting Opt-Ins—Marketing

Before sending any text messages through Digital Communication, it is important to collect your opt-ins first. For Marketing Text messages, it must be a literal opt-in. For an Operational Triggered Text, the opt-in can be gathered offline (see Operational Text Message for more details).

### Tips for collecting opt-ins:

- Send your members an email announcement that you offer text messaging
- Set up a page on your website explaining how to opt in
- Place an article in your newsletter
- Provide an interrupt page explaining how to opt in when logging into online banking

The following information could be sent as an email, adapted for an article in your newsletter, or posted on your website. It is the responsibility of the Financial Institution to confer with their Compliance Department for approval. Anything highlighted in **yellow**, please change to your institution. For anything highlighted in **gray**, we recommend getting approval from your Compliance Department.

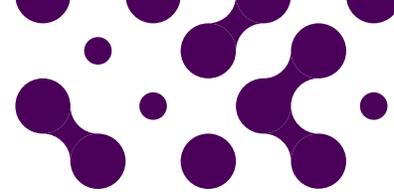
## How can I opt out of this service?

Messages are created and scheduled for delivery by **Marquis Federal**. We facilitate the opt-in/opt-out and delivery of text messages in direct compliance with the Mobile Marketing Code of Conduct.

Message frequency may vary. (if you do not know how often you will send messages or specify if you do know) You will receive up to six alerts per month once your subscription has been confirmed. You can opt out at any time by

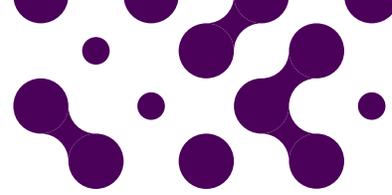
